

Southwest Motorsports High Performance Driver Education (HPDE)

SWMS offers High Performance Driver Education as an avenue to learn more about, and improve upon driving skills through rigorous classroom and on-track instruction by a team of experienced drivers/racers.

Driving in SWMS HPDE sessions are learning experiences, and should not be construed as racing sessions. Although we will build toward near-racing speeds, school sessions are offered as a way to learn precise driving lines, and to further knowledge of the rules of physics which govern driver/car behaviors in motion.

Instructors have the right to police all driving activities, including asking the student to slow his/her vehicle, change driving behavior, and/or to pull off the track for consultation. SWMS HPDE reserves the right to bar any student from further on-track activity, who does not accede to the instructor's wishes.

SWMS membership is not required for SWMS HPDE (your first two days). However, once graduated from the class you will be required to become a dues-paying member of SWMS in order to participate in either the Competition or Non-Competition events.

HPDE participants are required to attend all SWMS drivers' meetings, and to have their cars pass through SWMS Technical Inspection. The mandatory drivers' meeting both days will start at 8:00AM, with the first class session starting *immediately* after the end of the drivers' meeting.

HPDE participants will be required to attend all classroom and on-track sessions in order to graduate from the school, and to continue to the next level of on-track activity. **There are no exceptions.** Graduates will receive a SWMS driver's logbook to record their driving history.

We will teach you both the specifics of driving on the Sandia Motor Speedway 14-turn road course plus the general knowledge necessary to drive any car, anywhere, safely at high speeds.
